Guide for serving:

To Serve 100:

7 pans of 9x13 bars cut in 24 pieces each

13 dozen buns

100 cups coffee

50 cups lemonade (7 two quart pitchers)

Coffee & Lemonade will need to be adjusted as to the time of year.

Kitchen cleaning. Clean refrigerator inside and out. Ovens need to be cleaned inside and out.

Do NOT use oven cleaner or line with foil. Clean the stove tops and under the burners. Clean the electric percolators. (To clean, run three packages of unsweetened Lemon Kool Aid through each 100 cup pot, and two packages through each 55 cup pot.) Clean off the counter tops and wash the floor.

Because it has become difficult to get available workers for these functions, we can no longer prepare food other than sandwiches. If you choose to serve sandwiches, ingredients will be charged to you at Dietz Foods and you will be responsible for paying that bill directly to Dietz Foods. We will be happy to provide you with available caterers and prices if you wish. We will serve catered foods if so desired, but this can be a wonderful opportunity to accept offers of help from family and friends.

The United Church Women's Fellowship is pleased to have the opportunity to provide for families in bereavement and we are happy to do so. It is one of the ways we also serve the Lord.
