mission projects and quilting. Our quilting group meets on Tuesdays from 1:00—3:00 pm and has made quilts for couples being married and new babies. These reports are followed by a treasurer accounting, fun fellowship, and a delicious treat.

We usually have 8 to 10 members present. For a small group we carry on the necessary tasks such as the following: Coffee hour once a month, decorate Fellowship Hall tables for each season, supported the Back-Pack program at the school with \$300.00 donations, this year we purchased two \$40 gift baskets for Loaves & Fishes Food Shelf, shut-ins are given a gift at Christmas (this year it was a beautiful poinsettia plant), support Town and Country Days with items for the Silent Auction and working the booth, we purchase kitchen supplies, serve and provide refreshments for funerals of members and non-members, while Ruth and Joyce act as wedding coordinators for weddings held at United. Besides the above activities when it is our Church's turn, we serve coffee and bars for the Ecumenical services, drive Meals on Wheels, make the dinner for the Veteran's Banquet in November and provide help and food for the Blood Mobile.

We are able to do these worthwhile endeavors from money given to us for assisting families at funerals. Thanks to all of you who have been called on to work or furnish food during the past year. Won't you consider joining us for a couple hours on Monday afternoon?
